REGULATIONS

1) Police formalities

Any person who has to stay at least one night on the campsite would have to produce his identify papers to the manager or his representative and carry out the police formalities. Young persons without their parents are not allowed.

2) Taxes

Taxes will be paid to the Information Centre. Their amount is stuck up at the Information Center and depends on the number of nights spent on site. The bill has to be paid at least on the day of departure between 9 a.m. and 11 a.m. Another night will be added for delayed payments. **The rented campsite is available from 2 p.m on the arrival day and must be vacated by 11 a.m at least on departure day.**

3) Behavior

Campers are required to avoid any noise and talks which may disturb their neighbours, and to turn down their acoustic appliances. Complete silence between 10 p.m. and 8 a.m is required. **Dogs and other animals are only allowed if kept on a lead.** They must not be left on the campsite, even locked up in the absence of their owners who are civilly responsible for them. To relieve themselves, they must be taken outside the campsite, but under no circumstances on the parking spaces.

4) Traffic and parking

Inside the campsite speed is limited at 20 km/h. Vehicles must be parked on the rented campsite only. The access to the restaurant is forbidden for vehicle.

5) Keeping and look of the camp fittings

Everybody will have to respect the cleanliness and the hygiene of the campsite. Don't throw dirty water on the ground or in the gutters. Campers must throw away their sewage at appropriate places. Household waste must be packed in a plastic bag carrying the effigy of the "Camping Les 3 Lacs SA" (sold at the Information) before being deposited to the waste reception center (see the schedule). Containers are foreseen for the sorting of glass, PET-bottles, papers, batteries and metal. The campers are asked to use them. The wash and the drying of the linen will be made, if necessary, in the common Landry. A time slot must be reserved at the reception of the Camping. It is forbidden to plant nails in trees, to cut branches. The pitch

used during the stay will be kept in the state the camper found it when he arrived.

6) Security

a) Fire;

Open fires (wood, charcoal, etc.) are prohibited. Grills are allowed only on public fireplace. In case of fire, let the camp manager being informed immediately. Fire extinguishers are an everybody's disposal. A first-aid kit is available at the Information Centre and at the restaurant.

b) Theft;

Management is not responsible for the camper's things. Campers remain responsible for their own installation and have to let the manager being informed of any suspect presence. Though the campsite is watched over, campers are required to take care of their equipment.

7) Games

No noisy or disturbing game is allowed close to the campsite facilities but only on official play. Parents will always have to watch over their children.

8) Swimming pool

The bracelet of control for the swimming pool must be worn in the forearm. You have to wear the bracelet when you are in the swimming pool or in the surrounding. Any loss of the bracelet must be announced at once in the Information Center. Your guests can't use the swimming pool. The pool rules are posted in the pool area and must be followed.

9) Violations

In case one camper would disturb the stay of the other campers or would not respect the disposals of these rules and regulations, the manager or his representative could require the immediate departure. In the event of a criminal offence, the manager may call in the police. Any dispute between the parties relating to the interpretation or application of these rules which is not settled amicably shall be submitted to the competent court of the Lake District, in Murten, Canton of Fribourg. In case of disagreement, the french text is available.
